## CURRICULUM SCHEDULE

Reading/ELA: Our second module, of EL, focuses on biodiversity in the rainforest. Our focus skills will be summarizing a text (5.RI.2), text structure (5.RI.5), and comparing/contrasting text structure (5.RI.5). We will also analyze internet sources and informational text about the rainforest. We will prepare for a text-based discussion. The text-based discussion is part of our unit assessment. We have also started to make our green screen movies about the rainforest. The students did a lot of good research for their videos.

**Spelling:** Our spelling list will be for two weeks. It will be "Sort 4 suffixes." Students will receive a packet with several activities. The packet is due on 3-15-19 and the test will also be given on 3-15-19. The focus of this list is the "ion and ian" suffix.

**Science:** We will continue our new unit in science. Our unit is titled "Chemical Magic." We completed an experiment about acids and chemical reactions this week. Next week, we will discuss what fireworks, silly putty and rubber have in common.

Math: Chapter 6 of Go Math focuses on fractions. We will discuss reasonable estimates (5.NF.2), adding/subtracting fractions (5.NF.1-2) and Equivalent Fractions (5.NF.1). I have aligned students' MAP math scores to Khan Academy Mappers. Students can also access Khan Academy Mappers at home (just use their Google I.D.).
